

Local Maternity System Roadshow

Our ambition

Our vision for West Yorkshire and Harrogate Local Maternity System (LMS) is to provide the highest quality care, information and advice for women and their loved ones, whilst planning for a baby and throughout a pregnancy. We are working closely with women and their families to make sure they experience choice and personalised care that is safe, responsive and respectful to their needs and wishes throughout the pregnancy and birth.

Our ambition is to reduce stillbirths, neonatal deaths and brain injuries by 50% by 2025.

What we are doing

Continually improving maternity services is the responsibility of staff providing maternity care. **We wanted to ensure staff across West Yorkshire and Harrogate were aware of, and involved in the work, ambitions and progress of the Local Maternity System.**



Recently we have held a series of roadshows to allow us to showcase the work of the LMS and have conversations with staff in their workplace. We spoke to more than 350 maternity colleagues across the six local places in the LMS.



We worked with each trust to schedule and plan for their roadshow event which included an exhibition stand and representation from each LMS work stream;

- Safer maternity care
- Choice and personalisation
- Continuity of Carer
- Workforce
- Postnatal Care
- Perinatal Mental Health
- Maternity Voices Partnership (MVP)
- Preventing pre-term births
- Prevention (health and wellbeing before, during and after pregnancy)

- Digital Maternity
- Performance

Our team also visited the clinical areas in each Trust with a trolley, sharing refreshments and updates about the LMS.

On our roadshows partners including the Royal College of Midwives, the Yorkshire and Humber Clinical Network and the local staff wellbeing teams joined us to share their work with all who attended.

One of the main objectives during the roadshows was to demonstrate collective ownership of the LMS and to share information about what success looks like. It is very important that the LMS communicates how the workforce's involvement is crucial to achieving success and meeting its big ambitions.



The roadshows were well received and anecdotal feedback has been positive with requests for more roadshows later in 2020. Fantastic conversations were had with staff from across a range of professions and services. These conversations led to an enthusiasm from staff to become more involved in improving maternity services and the work of the LMS.
