

How your views have shaped our stroke work

Our ambition

A key part of the way we work across West Yorkshire and Harrogate is being open and honest about the work taking place so that people can get involved and have their say from the beginning. People who access health and social care often know better than us what keeps them well and healthy and what care they need to support their return to independence.

It is also important that people know how their views have shaped our work, for example improving stroke care across West Yorkshire and Harrogate.



How did we do this?

- > Since our engagement and conversations with staff, partners and the public began in February 2017, we have continually kept people updated throughout to try and ensure everyone had the opportunity to have their say on the development of our stroke care work.
- > We talked to over 2500 people over 18 months, including voluntary, community organisations, people who have had a stroke, unpaid carers, councillors and staff.
- > We developed a survey, had conversations with people in their communities and in our hospitals. There was also a series of events in each of our local areas.
- > Information has been kept updated and been made available in alternative formats, the media, social media and websites.
- > Our partners shared information across their communication channels – making sure we reached as many people as possible.
